"Neglect is the **persistent failure** to meet a child's **basic physical and/or psychological needs**, likely to result in the **serious impairment**

of the child's **health or development**. Once a child is born, neglect may involve a parent or carer failing to: provide adequate food, clothing and shelter (including exclusion from home or abandonment); protect a child from physical and emotional harm or danger; ensure adequate supervision (including the use of inadequate care-givers); or ensure access to appropriate medical care or treatment. It may also include neglect of, or unresponsiveness to, a child's basic emotional needs." <u>If</u> <u>you have any concerns about ANY child at school, where you live</u> <u>etc. please contact Junaida Bana</u>
