Physical Education (PE) and Yoga:

English:

This term children will be exposed to a number of high quality texts including Fox by Margaret Wild . Children will be taught a variety of writing skills including use of homophones, contractions and use of possessive apostrophe as stipulated in the National Curriculum through a number of mediums including monologues, diaries and postcards. We will kick off the term with Shakespeare week and reading the Tempest.

Science:

Children will explore and compare both living and non living things. Also our scientists will identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. Finally, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food, children will apply their learning to familiar habitats.
