## BOOK THE COURSE!

Please book a place on the Compassionate Parenting course on 22nd March between 5.30 and 7.30. At only £5 this will be a practical and valuable opportunity to think about how we all communicate which will impact, we hope, on the relationships we have with children at home and in school. Safeguarding is EVERYONE'S responsibility - attend a course with Junaida on 18th March to know more about how safeguarding at Avanti Court protects everyone and our children. Reports will be going out on Friday 15th March. These are longer reports which will give you an idea how your child has progressed. You will notice that your child will have targets which we hope you will support. You will have an opportunity to discuss this at the parent consultation on Thursday 21st March. These meetings are 10 minutes long - 5 minutes looking at children's books and 5 minutes in discussion with your child's class teacher.

**Propose to change time of school day** in September 2013: As we share the site with IJPS this year we were restricted with deciding the hours of our school day. Our day is longer than most primary schools with learning time as 5hours and 25mins. In line with other primary schools hours we propose our school day to start at 8.30 and finish at 3.00pm (5hours and 15mins learning time). This will not be detrimental to children's learning especially for young children for whom our current school day is very long.

**Reception Parents!!** Please remember that we need you to help us build a profile of your child's learning and progress. Please collect information about your child - take photos of them doing something that surprised you, write a note to your class teacher explaining something that your child did, bring in a piece of learning ( a drawing, some writing, some maths). We really need this because without it we only know 1/2 your child. If you are a bit unsure what you should be doing, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.
