Last year, children worked on their "kick ups", which is the key exercise to developing overall motor skills, agility and co-ordination. 3 children (just at the age of 6) have improved so drastically, such that they are capable of doing 50 kick-ups continuously with both feet – something that the older children sometimes struggle to do! The improvement shown was unbelievable!
