Philosophy Religion and Ethics Education

Topic: Communicating with the divine

Pupils will learn about the meaning of prayer. They will focus in more depth on the power and meaning of meditation (exploring the similarities and differences of chanting the Maha Mantra with chants from other traditions e.g. Hail Mary) as an individual and collective practice. They will ask questions about the nature of the Divine: e.g. How can we make contact with Krishna? Does He listen? How do we know?
