Christophe's Story

- Empathise with characters in a story; debate moral dilemmas

Numeracy

Common Fraction, decimal fractions and Time measurement

- Recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions.
- Count up and down in hundredths;
- Time
- Convert between different units of measure, e.g. hour to minute.
- Read, write & convert time between analogue and digital 12 and 24 hour clocks.
- Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths.
- Write decimal equivalents
- Find the effect of dividing a one or two digit number

Science: Electricity link to Global Warming

- Use symbols to represent components of an electrical circuit in drawings.
- Electricity can be dangerous so care needs to be taken.
- Know what electrical energy can come through mains electricity or battery power.
- Know which devices use which type of power source and why.
- Know that electrical energy is converted into heat, light, sound, movement.
- Know the dangers of mains power supply
