Geometry and measurement - Illustrate and name parts of circles, including radius, diameter and circumference and know that the diameter is twice the radius.

Statistics - Calculate the mean as an average.

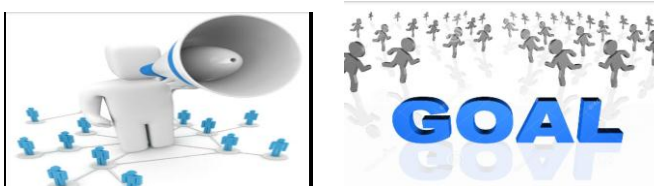
Algebra and time - Use simple formulae.
