Reading and completing the Student Planner with your child

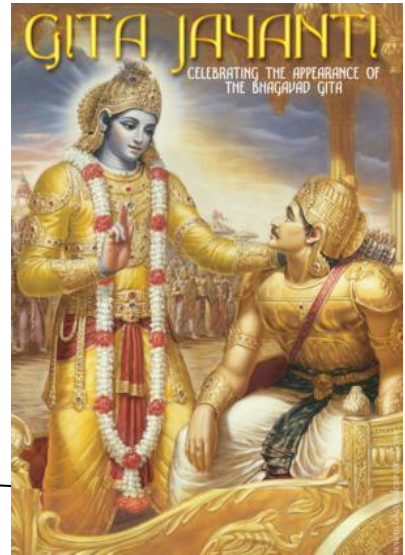
- Home/ School Agreement must be completed– please sign it. Any concerns that will be raised.
