Shaha Vatra

Snana Yatra is a <u>bathing festival</u> celebrated on <u>Purnima</u> (full moon day) of the <u>Hindu</u> month of <u>Jyeshtha</u>. It is an important festival for the <u>Jagannath</u> devotees. This is the first occasion in the year, as per the Hindu calendar, when the deities <u>Jagannath</u>, <u>Balabhadra</u>, <u>Subhadra</u>, Sudarshan, and Madanmohan are brought out from the <u>Jagannath Temple</u> (<u>Puri</u>) and taken in a procession to the Snana Bedi. There they are ceremonially bathed and decorated for a public audience with the devotees.
